

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING -- AMENDMENT OF CURRENT BUDGET

The Johnson County EMA Commission of Johnson County Iowa will meet at: 4529 Melrose Avenue, Iowa City, IA. 52246 in the Policy Board Room, on **May 28th 2020 at 4:00 P.M.** for the purpose of amending the current FY20 budget for the EMA Commission of Johnson County Iowa's budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, by increasing expenditures in the following fund: EMA Budget Expense Fund from \$4,545,441.00 to \$4,605,441.00

Reasons for increases: expenses and revenues related to federal, state and other grants and costs related to grants, Covid 19 pandemic response, and interagency fund transfers from sources expended in this budget year due to increased costs related to the covid 19 pandemic response.

The increase in expenditures set out above will be met from increased receipts and/or cash balances not budgeted or considered in the current budget.

There will be no increase in taxes to be paid in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020. Any residents or taxpayers will be heard for or against the proposed amendment at the time and place specified above. A detailed statement of: additional receipts (other than taxes), cash balances on hand at the close of the preceding fiscal year, and proposed disbursements, both past and anticipated, will be available at the hearing.

RECORD OF HEARING AND DETERMINATION ON THE AMENDMENT TO BUDGET

The Johnson County EMA Commission of Johnson County, Iowa lawfully met on **May 28th 2020, at 4:00 P.M.** at the place and time set in the public notice for the purpose of amending the current Johnson County EMA Commission FY20 budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020. The Commission reviewed the affidavit of publication and then directed it be placed on file with the County Auditor. Upon taking up the proposed amendment, it was considered and residents and taxpayers were heard for or against the amendment. Thereafter, and after hearing all residents and all taxpayers to be heard, the Board took up the amendment to the budget for final consideration and determined that said budgeted expenditures be amended as follows: EMA Commission and Agency Budget Fund from \$4,545,441.00 to \$4,605,441.00
