- Member updates/reports from industry and community partners-all.
 - Ken Brown from ICFD & JCHMRT reported that a new agreement is now in place with Cedar County and that the Hazmat team will be covering the entire Southern half as of September 23, 2009.
- Annex P and Cameo updates/status report. (BJ)

 - There are currently 69 tier II facilities registered in Johnson County and they are in the H.E.R.E. system & the Cameo system on the haz mat computers & at EMA.
- Multi Hazard Plan update and upcoming ESF conversion from Annex P to ESF 10 (work group volunteers).
 - EMA will be converting the Annex P plan over to ESF 10 in the next few months. Please email B.J. Dvorak @ <u>bjdvorak@co.johnson.ia.us</u> if you would like to assist with this project. We will have 3 meetings and it is to be done by February 1st 2010.
- Haz Mat Team report or areas of concern-Ken
 - Hazmat Team responded to a diesel spill call in North Liberty on July 28th, 2009.
 - 2 new Level A suits were purchased to go on the hazmat truck.
 - Hazmat river boom trailer & Special Ops trailer are currently being stored at Johnson County Secondary Roads across the street & down the road from Haz mat 1 on Melrose avenue.

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- Notes from SERC meeting in Des Moines last week. (BJ)
 - The State may be having a possible workshop on how to put the ESF 10 plan together.
 - Under the Rules Committee Chapter 605, many of the rules were technology changes from the 100-104 chapters.
 - HMEP Grant Approval is underway for FFY 2010 and award letters should be out shortly.
 - Gary Brown, Region 4 Emergency Planning District Chair, discussed concerns with EMA's making the EHS Planning circles as a part of CAMEO and the county multihazard
 - plan. A committee has been put together to discuss further options regarding this issue.
 - There are currently 3,857 Tier II facilities in Iowa.
- Haz Mat Ops class grant status- present yr. vs. applied for, and commodity flow study. (BJ)
 - During the FFY 2009 HMEP grant period, Johnson County started with \$2,817.81 that was used to conduct Hazmat Operations & refresher classes for first responders. Only \$875.00 of that was spent. Unsure why this was so low this year. We need to do better next year or the grant will undoubtedly decrease.
 - During the FFY 2010 HMEP grant period, Johnson County has again asked for funding for classes along with planning funds to conduct a commodity flow study.
